

General Policy Statement.

The Company has the maintenance and improvement of Safety, Health, Welfare and Environmental standards as one of its declared objectives. It is resolved that all necessary measures shall be taken subject to the statutory duties set out in legislation to secure the health, safety and welfare of its employees in their place of work and to protect persons other than employees against risks to their normal health and safety which may arise from work activities at Company premises. It will use the best possible environmental practices in all its activities and promote the recycling of materials wherever it is practicable to do so.

In particular, the company will: -

- Provide and maintain safe and healthy working conditions taking account of any legal and semi-legal requirements.
- Provide information, instruction, training and supervision to enable employees to perform their work safely and efficiently.
- Arrange for sufficient funds and resources to meet the requirements of the policy.
- Make available all necessary safety devices and protective equipment and supervise their use.
- Maintain a constant and continuing interest in health, safety and environmental matters applicable to the Company's activities in particular by clear leadership, example, and by consulting and involving employees.
- Improve the environment through its products, processes and services by reducing waste and encouraging recycling.

All employees must exercise personal responsibility for their health and safety and that of others who may be affected by their work activities. The support of all employees is required to ensure the success of the Company's Safety, Health and Environmental Policy
